## **Ambulance**

• Ambulances – two front line and one ready spare

- Paramedic on duty will "triage" the call and respond with ambulance
  - o If call needs para will go on call
  - o If does not will come back to be on crew of second ambulance
- Staffing
  - Mostly FT some PT and Per Diem
  - o 13 qualified paramedics
  - o 16 EMT's
  - Full timers are scheduled for 48 hours/week (so get 8 hours/week of OT at time and a half) this is less expensive than hiring another employee with salary and benefits
- CTE/Explorer program hard to have consistency and possibility of staying
  - Can't keep training and losing to college
  - o Need ability to have on call or ability to work consistently
- Approx. 2k calls/year = 6 calls/day
- Estimated \$840k in transport revenue for 2024
- Budget up 6.2%
  - O Wages are down 1.7%
  - o Per Diem down
  - o OT down

- Purchased services
  - software pediatric app went from \$650/year to \$2,115
  - software IM Responding \$660
- o Training and development \$1500 conference (Image Trend)
- o Contractual vehicles \$4400 maintenance on ambulance
- Supplies adding a phone for captains
- Possibility of Ambulance Revolving Fund
  - Would use transport \$
  - \$130k put in every year so that in 5 years have \$ to buy ambulance
  - Would need a vote on warrant to spend the \$

## Town Budget

- Salary ranges in Milford
  - Looking to continue multi-phase process
  - o Bringing about 20 employees this year to mid-range of Milford salaries (8 were Ambulance)
  - Current healthcare buyout is 4k talking about raising to 10k
  - About 190 FT and 20-30 PT employees in Milford
  - o Talk over potential cuts
    - Votes by BOS will be taken on 12/27
- Budget and Bond hearing will be Jan 8<sup>th</sup>

## Misc.

• Mill St. – someone purchased and wants to build a 52ft high, 32-unit apartment building
