1. **Opening.**
 - Selectman Gary Daniels opened the meeting at 6:30 p.m.
2. **Approval of Minutes**
 - George Hoyt moved to approve the minutes of December 17, 2013. Bert Becker second. All were in favor and the motion passed.
3. **Old Business.**
 - **Scale House Replacement Project**
 - What is the status of the permit?
 - Recycling Committee members would like the committee to control the process, recognizing the necessary involvement of the Town Administrator, DPW Director and Building Inspector.
4. **New Business.**
 - **Sludge Transportation**
 - Transfer Station personnel are being used to transport sludge to Merrimack, with reimbursement made into a Transfer Station fund set up by Finance Director Jack Sheehy. To date, nine loads have been transported. How much is in the fund?
 - Trucks are being overloaded. This is a problem.
 - **Future Recycling at Keyes Park**
 - Estimate that six recycling bins will be needed for the park. Rather than spend thousands buying high-priced containers, the committee discussed the possibility of using 55-gallon drums. Can covers be purchased for 55-gallon drums?

 - Gary Daniels will provide approved minutes to the Town Administrator, the DPW Director, and the Community Media Director, who will post them on the town Web site.
 - Gary Daniels will check on the status of the permit.
 - Jerry Guthrie will research the possibility of purchasing 55-gallon drum covers.
