Emergency Medical Technician – BASIC

This course is approved by the NH Bureau of Fire Standards and Training and Emergency Medical Services and meets the current US Department of Transportation Emergency Medical Technician – Basic (EMT-B) curriculum. This course will provide students with training on treatment and skills for EMT-B certification and cover human anatomy and physiology plus concepts, skills and treatment for illness and traumatic injury, emergency driving, CPR, NH Transition Modules and more. This class meets twice per week for four hours totaling one hundred twenty eight hours. Students must be 18 years of age prior to completion of the program and in good physical health. **Testing and exam fees are not included in tuition.**

\$100 non-refundable deposit required with registration. Registration closes August 31st, 2011.

Minimum of 12 students required to hold course.

Program Cost: \$725 (does not include testing fees)
