

## Community Development Planner

The Town of Milford, NH, is seeking a full-time qualified, motivated, and creative Community Development Planner to be responsible for land-use planning and technical support on behalf of the Office of Community Development. This diversified position manages the review and analysis of the Town's permitting for land use and development applications; assists and provides reports and recommendations to an active planning board and other boards and commissions, committees, developers, land owners, and the general public on Town regulations and land use data; prepares and writes documents relative to short-term and long-range planning regulations, codes, and policies; attends and participates at meetings; and manages the Town GIS system.

Minimum requirements include a Bachelor's Degree in urban or city planning and 4 to 10 years of related experience in municipal planning and working skill in GIS. Master's Degree in urban and regional planning and related experience is preferred. Knowledge of zoning, subdivision, site plan, and land development regulatory processes is essential, as is the ability to communicate effectively, both written and verbal, with staff, boards, committees, and the general public. The successful applicant must be customer-service oriented. Knowledge of surveying and civil engineering is a plus. The position is part of a progressive team that includes community development, building and code enforcement, environmental programs, conservation, and health.

This is an exempt position in the Town's wage scale. Salary range is \$57,891 - \$89,144 depending on qualifications and experience and includes full Town benefits.
