The Town of Milford is pleased to announce that it will begin a series of public outreach sessions to receive community input on the designs for Phase II of the Downtown Traffic & Pedestrian Improvements.

Phase II represents the next stage of the Town's effort to enhance the economic and physical conditions within the downtown districts. The project builds upon the 2009 CLD Traffic and Pedestrian Improvement Evaluation for Downtown Milford final report and would include roadway widening/improvements, sidewalk reconstruction, pedestrian safety enhancements, and streetscape improvements to the Oval Area and Nashua Street, Clinton Street, and Tonella Road.

Members of the Community Development Department and Nashua Regional Planning Commission will provide a brief overview of the project areas and past efforts. This will be followed by an interactive public input session with residents, property and business owners, and other stakeholders. The comments will then be used to help create the final project design.
