***Pergola***

**Discussion Items:**

Keyes Skate Park was vandalized. One of the ramp structures was modified taking the concrete footing out and replacing it with wood. The skate park was closed temporarily (half day), the damage was repaired, and the skate park is open again.

The state swim meet fee for pool usage is now late and has not been paid by GSSA. GSSA is requiring more billing information before they will pay for the invoice. The Town is looking into the reasons behind this decision.
