There was no quorum for the February commission meeting. These are notes concerning the discussions the present members conducted. No official business took place.

Nicole reviewed the director's report. She said some items in the revolving fund were moved around to make it more concise and easier to work with.

Transfer \$91.46 from fitness programs to kickboxing and Halloween line items.
Transfer \$2138.48 from basketball league to recreation general.

2011 Park Projects:

Kaley Park – phase II

Baby pool resurfacing scheduled for this year.

Shepard Park improvements were discussed. Nicole said plans for an expansion of the ice rink are looking good and some money for the East Milford fund could be used for resurfacing the infield and renovating the dugouts.

Bids for the tennis and basketball court resurfacing bids have been prepared.

Some of the pool shade tarps need to be replaced.

Member contact information was reviewed and updated.

The middle school enrichment program is no longer in existence. The commission needs to find a new entity to run the concession stand. Nicole will ask if MCAA is interested in running the stand.

Swim lessons – Boys and Girls Club will participate in swim lessons for those with pool passes. Asked for recreation department to take care of administration of the swim lesson program. Rick Mossey stated that a large expense in running his business is administrative costs. The commission members present suggested that if the Recreation Department was to take on this role and incur the added expense there would be no incentive for the town to offer the group discount given to the Boys and Girls Club.

MICE Team:

Nicole said there are plans to have a season end debriefing and gathering for the members to thank them for their hard work this year and to continue to have everything run well next year.
