Bill Sprague would like to raise money again next year for the Fourth of July fireworks. The VFW will not be raising money for the fireworks this year. They will be putting their money towards the Labor Day Parade. The cost of the fireworks will be around \$5000.

Fourth of July-

Keyes Park- Leak in the pool roof. The main pool needs to be resurfaced. The baby pool has been resurfaced and is looking great. Next year the pool will absolutely need to be resurfaced. Next year the plan is for the resurfacing to be put in the towns operating budget. The resurfacing will be around 40-50K.

The Skateboard Park will need some patching and repairing of the concrete structures.

A shade system for the baby pool is being considered. The quote for the shade is \$6300. The Keyes Memorial Trust has been asked to donate the money. They are reviewing the options. The commission is for the shade system but would like a few more quotes. We will make a decision next meeting.

Steve Trombley has begun phase two of Kaley Park. Trees are now being cleared and there will be construction at the park for the summer.

Blue bus system for Milford residents is running. Additional routes may be provided.

Thank you letters will be sent to MCAA for donating soccer nets to Keyes. The shed donated by Larry Miller and the snow blower donated by Joyce Monbleau for the ice rink will also receive thank you letters.

Bill Rouff is no longer with the town. Rick Riendeau is the interim head of the DPW.

State Swim Meet will not be held at Keyes Field Pool. The town will hopefully be able to host the swim meet in the future.

The Recreation Commission will host the Share food Pasta Dinner two Tuesdays this month.
