Programs

Events:

- Sounds on the Souhegan Concert Series will be Wednesdays from July 4th-August 29th.
- July 4th will be Family fun day and fireworks at Keyes. We need volunteers. There will be a free pool pass that day, and there will not be a bonfire this year due to the smoke obscuring the fireworks. We may have a bonfire at Keyes in the fall.
- This year Milford will host the State swim meet. The date will be August 4th (rain date August 5th). Volunteers will be needed for parking (in the AM) and for vending. The meet is now scheduled as a one day event. Due to the number of swimmers the event would be better served over the course of two days. Nicole has spoken with GSSA about having the event run over a two day period. Due to the cost of the pool rental it is now tentatively scheduled for one day.

Discussion Items:

- Concession Services Agreement- Two copies of the agreement was signed by Joan Dargie and members of the recreation commission.

- The recreation department will have a summer intern from May 21st-August 17th.
- There has been discussions regarding having a designated smoking area at Keyes. There is already no smoking on the tennis courts and in the skate park. There has been much littering with Cigarette butts. The commission would like to put in two receptacles for cigarettes in a couple of areas around the park.
- Keyes Pool Plaque- There was a small plaque on the front of the pool house and another sign that listed the Keyes Trust and members of the town that helped to make the pool a reality. There will be a dedication potentially on July 4th. The wording of the plaque will be as follows:
