●**SHARE CLOTHING BARN** provides free clothing for residents of Milford, Amherst, Brookline and Mont Vernon.

●**BRIDGE BARGAINS THRIFT STORE** 12 Spaulding Street Milford. All proceeds will go to SHARE Outreach and other local charity organizations.

Acceptable donations are clothing and accessories, kitchen items, sheets and other linens, blankets, quilts, comforters, pottery, holiday items, house decorations, small un-upholstered furniture, lamps, tools, sporting goods, small to medium rugs, craft items, decorative lawn items.



●**CONSIGNING FOR GOOD** is a shop at 172 South Street, Milford Accepts items such as furniture and household items, antiques, sporting goods, pictures, dishes, etc. Call 249-9481 for more information. You can donate your goods and choose a nonprofit to receive the proceeds.

●**STILL GOOD SHED** at Milford Recycling & Transfer Station

Takes non-upholstered furniture, household goods, tools, books, toys etc in Good and clean condition. Open during Transfer station hours.

●**GOODWILL** Route 101A Amherst NH The mission is to enable persons with diverse challenges to achieve personal stability and community engagement through work in their stores and recycling.

They accept clothing and household goods, books and toys. They take single shoes, ripped clothing, computers, eyeglasses, random wires all for recycling.

Recycling collection bins at the Milford Recycling Center and elsewhere in town:



1. **PLANET AID**—clothing and shoes only. Sold domestically and overseas. Funds generated go toward sustainable development projects and education in developing countries.

2. **SALVATION ARMY**-clothing and shoes in collection bins.
