1. **Opening.** Selectman Gary Daniels opened the meeting at 6:30 p.m.
2. **Approval of Minutes**
 - **Approval of 04/24/12 Minutes.** The approval of the 04/24/12 minutes was deferred because a quorum was not present.
3. **Old Business.**
 - The committee was updated on the recycling status within the school system. There are currently two dumpsters at each of four locations. One dumpster is used for solid waste, the other for recycled material. The current recycling/solid waste contact at the school is about \$43,000. The school is currently taking bids for a new contract to begin August 1, 2012.
 - Dave Bowden provided drawings to the committee of proposed expansion of the Still Good Shed. The committee will be checking to determine if the project could be done by the Building Trades class at the High School, and/or Boy Scouts.
4. **New Business.**
 - **Recycling Ordinance Modifications**
 - Members continued and completed their discussion on proposed changes and restructuring of the Recycling/Solid Waste Ordinance. Selectman Daniels will submit the rewritten ordinance to Selectmen for hearings and approval.
5. **Action Items:**
 - **School Recycling Contract**
 - Bert Becker will track the developments in the school recycling/solid waste contract.
 - **Facility Enhancements**
 - Dave Bowden will work on Still Good Shed expansion to determine labor coverage and material cost.
 - **Recycling Ordinance Modifications**
 - Gary Daniels will submit the rewritten ordinance to Selectmen for hearings and approval.
 - **Recycling Brochure**
 - Celeste Barr will track the progress on the new recycling/solid waste brochure.
 - **Transfer Station Signage**
 - Tammy Scott will order additional signage needed to guide residents in correctly disposing of their recyclables at the appropriate location with the Transfer Station
