Description of matters discussed and final decisions made. **Note:** Any votes taken must be recorded "in such a manner that the vote of each member is ascertained and recorded":

(RSA 91-A:3, II (d)) Land Acquisition - Administrator Daley was approached by a Milford resident who wants to buy the Grenale Property. The property has contamination that needs to be addressed. The property needs to be tested. Thousands of dollars are owed in back taxes. The Town doesn't want this property and the owner won't clean it up or pay the taxes. Administrator Daley will reach out to the owner to let him know that there is an opportunity to get funding to help with the testing. The owner doesn't live on the property. There was additional discussion about what to do with the property as well as getting the state involved.

(RSA 91-A:3, II (e)) Legal — The contract for Milford Spartan Solar is due to expire in September. Administrator Daley asked the Board for input on what they want to do going forward. The owner of the property also dealing with Milford Spartan Solar is not interested in extending his contract and will be notifying Milford Solar shortly. The Towns portion for solar is 100 acres but Milford Spartan is only using 30 acres of the 100 which may change if the abutting property owner cancels his contract. Additional discussion included other options for the property. Additional parties are interested in the property in question. There were several options for extending the contract for 1 year with multiple clauses. The Board asked Lincoln to ask Milford Spartan Solar for any data on the property that they should have collected in the last several years.

Selectman Labonte doesn't think we should be in non-public under (RSA 91-A:3, II (e)) Legal. He feels it should be more under Reputation. Chairman Daniels will disclose the error when they go back into the public meeting.

Administrator Daley said he would like a vote by the Board about extending the contract by the next meeting. Selectman Labonte doesn't feel we need a vote, just let the contract run out.

**Note**: Under RSA 91-A:3, III. Minutes of proceedings in nonpublic sessions shall be kept and the record of all actions shall be promptly made available for public inspection, except as provided in this section. Minutes and decisions reached in nonpublic session shall be publicly disclosed within 72 hours of the meeting, unless, by a recorded vote of 2/3 of the members present, **taken in public session**, it is determined that divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of any person **other than a member of this board**, or render the proposed action of the board ineffective, or pertain to terrorism. In the event of such circumstances, information may be withheld until, in the opinion of a majority of members, the aforesaid circumstances no longer apply.
