(RSA 91-A:3, II (e)) The Selectmen held an emergency meeting on Friday, August 12, 2022 in regards to a significant Town employee who terminating his employment. The meeting was posted in advance on the front page of the town website and in hard copy on the towns public bulletin boards where notices are normally posted. A citizen didn't like the way the minutes were written and filed a complaint with the state Ombudsman who rule in that citizens favor.

A discussion ensured about the public minutes that were written by former Chairman Dargie, versus the minutes that the town Attorney John Ratigan suggested. The current approved minutes are posted on the Town's website.

There were multiple suggestions to change the wording of the previous minutes.

Selectman Dargie said he would modify the suggestions and he and the Town Administrator meet with Attorney Ratigan to review the revised minutes for clarification.

Note: Under RSA 91-A:3, III. Minutes of proceedings in nonpublic sessions shall be kept and the record of all actions shall be promptly made available for public inspection, except as provided in this section. Minutes and decisions reached in nonpublic session shall be publicly disclosed within 72 hours of the meeting, unless, by recorded vote of 2/3 of the members present, **taken in public session**, it is determined that divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of any person **other than a member of this board**, or render the proposed action of the board ineffective, or pertain to terrorism. In the event of such circumstances, information may be withheld until, in the opinion of a majority of members, the aforesaid circumstances no longer apply.
