Cemetery Trustee Meeting Minutes June 20, 2017

- 1. A presentation was given by Cameron Audette regarding an Eagle Scout project he wishes to do in West Street Cemetery. He would like to upright and/or repair stones in the cemetery. Troy will check out the work and then determine if the project can go forward. - 4. Due to the completion of the Fletcher site work adjoining the Elm Street Cemetery, replacement of the fence surrounding the cemetery is necessary. A motion was made by Mary to allow Ricky to get quotes for the purchase and installation of a chain link fence (black) for enclosure of the Elm Street Cemetery. If the best quote was less than \$12,000 he can proceed. The motion was seconded by Kris. All voted in favor.
- 5. As there were no further items for discussion, a motion was made by Kris to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Steve. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 2:10 pm.
