Due to expanded programming with the creation of the about Milford series staffing requirements will increase. The first step in the process is to formally document the job description for each position. Chris presented draft job descriptions for feedback and will have them formalize by HR.

Tightrope (Cablecast) Service Contract

- Chris recommended we purchase a hardware and software service contract for our Tightrope equipment. This equipment is responsible for: program scheduling, bulletin board, live streaming and video on demand. The contract is transferrable to new equipment. This is essential as over the next year we plan to replace several servers so we are able to deliver high definition (HD) TV.
- He also recommended we use their cloud based streaming service for live streaming and video on demand (VoD). This reduces the amount of upload bandwidth we require. The service is able to tailor each stream for different devices and connection speeds. Programs continue to be hosted on our equipment

but are cached in the cloud. Annual cost is \$2,200 to stream a maximum of three live channels and VoD.
