Manager Report

- ➤ VoD latency issues have mostly been resolved. Town Hall to GTM rack at high school link was upgraded to Gigabit and the internal LAN within the rack is being upgraded to 10G Ethernet as soon as equipment arrives. Traffic routing was changed to improve performance. Chris is working with Comcast to upgrade the GTM Cable internet connection at the high school and replace existing analog multichannel PEG modulator with digital SDI gear in preparation of Comcast enabling one of our PEG channels in HD.
- Fiber cables have been installed at high school to replace copper drops at various locations. Optical to copper interfaces have been purchased but not yet installed.
- Extensive Pumpkin festival video shot, still in post-production editing. Coverage includes: Pumpkin lighting, Robert Kokko award and Milford Spooky Stamp first day. Molly St Onge recorded the Talent Show.
- ➤ Sports coverage volunteers are doing a great job covering games. New volunteers signed up for basketball and wrestling coverage. Some of the away games will be covered live on Facebook in cooperation with other groups. Monadnock Roller Derby is on the Bulletin Board

Budget

Chris presented a rough draft of proposed 2020 budget. Except for new assistant position expenses are about same as 2019. Planned capital projects for next year: 1) Audio upgrades at high school and town hall, 2) acquire camera optimized for sports coverage, 3) two video editing computers to allow public program editing for broadcast on GTM, 4) Internet capable camera to allow live broadcast from remote locations.
