1. **Opening.**

3. Old Business.

• 37th NRRA Recycling Conference is in Manchester May 21 and 22nd. There is a discounted ticket for more than 3 people from an organization such as the town to attend. Tammy will be attending for the Town of Milford. Diane Varney-Parker and MMS students will be attending on 5/22 for the Milford School District Recycling efforts and to receive an award.

4. **New Business**

- A recycling barrel at Keyes was destroyed.
- Jerry did inspections of tall the locations of town owned Recycling bins and all have been placed out for spring except MCAA.
- Kathy will try to contact Troy Swanick at Milford DPW to get some placed there as the fields are busy and many recyclables are disposed of there.
- Celeste requested Tammy send the Milford trash and recycling data for 2017 to the committee members. Gil requested a hard copy.
- The MMS is working with the MHS Green Club to try to help spread their experience and recycling success to the Milford High School.
- MMS will celebrate Green Week with a different environmental theme each day of the week. Several MMS and MHS Green Club students will be meeting with Congresswoman Kuster to share their efforts at waste reduction and recycling.
- Boomerang Bag update: another sewing bee and new volunteers to sew reusable shopping bags and help reduce consumption of single use plastics in the area.
- George proposed working on a plastic Bag ban in Milford. Diane shared some helpful information on that from the NH Plastic Pollution Alliance and MassGreen.org
- George sent a request to MHS Graphic Arts instructors to ask if students could design a new recycling brochure for the Town. He offered a \$50 prize for the design that is chosen. George will bring the entries to the next meeting for review.

5. Upcoming

- Jerry Guthrie asked if the committee would be interested in participating in the Milford Labor Day Parade as a way to promote recycling and waste reduction. The idea was well received and the Committee brainstormed possible float ideas.
- One idea was to recreate the walking Recycling Float from 20 years ago with a shopping cart (borrowed from local supermarket) for each item recycled by the Town of Milford: #1 Plastics #2 plastics, glass, aluminum, paper, corrugated cardboard, leaves and brush, motor oil etc. The Recyclemobile could also be part of the 'float'. The Recyclemobile will then be dropped at the Cookout area at end of parade route (Souhegan Boys and Girls club).
- The Committee would also like to recreate their original 'Operation Separation' mascot Trash Cannie. He no longer exists so will have to be recreated.
