  - 17 barrels are currently placed
  - We have 14 tops in use
  - We have been waiting for tops for three months

## Pay As You Throw (PAYT)

- > The Town of Tilton has had PAYT for two years, with curbside pickup and dropoff
  - Started PAYT, then stopped
  - Bags were priced at \$1.00 and \$0.50
  - Illegal dumping increased on the roadside
  - Couldn't convince citizens that they were not being doubled-billed
  - Difficult transition
  - Warnings caused major concern
  - Uncertain on effect of PAYT
- Amherst recycling is comprehensive
- > Target for completion of study was set for the end of August
- ➤ Will municipal waste be exempt from PAYT?
- Can one-stop recycling be accomplished in Milford?
- > Diane and Celeste have been invited to speak at Congregational Church lyceum.
