- Jerry contacted Troy Swanick of Milford DPW to request some recycling bins be put in Keyes Park as the Park is used year round and there is only one recycling barrel at the pavilion (far across the snow from playground, basketball, walking trail and skateboard park.
- Celeste requested Tammy send the Milford trash and recycling data for 2017 to the committee members. Gil requested a hard copy.
- George said "The Transfer station needs more help" Gary suggested the Committee discuss staffing needs at the Recycling Center 6-9 months from now since the town has just passed the new municipal budget.

## **Schedule of Future Recycling Education spotlights:**

- March 2018 – Metals educational presentation by Tammy Scott.  
The tow of Milford Town accepts computer monitors and printers for \$10 each, CPUs and laptops cost \$5, and TVs <19" cost \$10. TVs over 19" cost \$20 to dispose of. Fax machines can be recycled for free.  
A local Nashua Company RMG recycles these electronics. Stop at the Transfer Station office to recycle these items and pay the fee.  
Plastic phones can be thrown into trash but they are rechargeable phones, please remove the batteries to be recycled first.  
Electronics with refrigerants such as refrigerators and air conditioners cost \$16 to dispose of.

- May 2018 meeting--Metals educational presentation by Tammy

- Creating an educational Transfer Station “tour” video for posting on the Web and viewing on the cable access channel—George will followup with Mike McInerney
