 - MMS is having a Green Week again for the week of May 22-26. Guests are expected all week, plus fun activities and contests will be conducted to promote being "Green"/Earth Friendly
 - MMS is still doing well collecting for Terracycle, but sadly Terracycle has stopped their juice pouch brigade so a search is being conducted to identify other schools or groups to which collected juice pouches could be donated
