- Due to the lack of any significant rainfall in the past several months, Milford is now experiencing a drought with the water table dropping to dangerously low levels and significant impacts to the Souhegan River. As a result, and at the request of the state, we have now imposed an outside watering ban. This means that the Board of Water and Sewer Commissioners have implemented total outside water use restrictions on the watering of gardens, lawns, and other landscaped areas; the washing of cars, trucks, RVs, driveways, sidewalks, patios, and decks; and the filling of swimming pools from the water system. These restrictions apply to water users of the town water system and they do not apply to water users that get their water from personal wells. The town strongly encourages well water users to also follow these restrictions. The Board of Water and Sewer Commissioners and Board of Selectmen will provide periodic updates to the municipal water users and public accordingly.
