The attorney for Marmon alerted me late this morning that it now appears the applicant will not be prepared to move forward with either the Variance nor the Special Exception Cases in time for the May 16th **Requested** Hearing Date.

Therefore, the town requested that the applicant now provide a both a formal request to shift the scheduled meeting date to the June 6th, as they have now requested below; as well as the required (formal) **90 Day Decision Waiver**, since the project's **90th Day** would have otherwise been May 23rd since their application (2/22) submittal date.

This will confirm our telephone conversation of this morning. On behalf of the applicant, I am amending our request for the continuance of the hearings on our two applications from this evening to a later date. The original request was to extend to May 16th. We are now requesting that the hearings be continued to June 6th. As you know, there have been some concerns raised by an abutter, and we are in discussions to address those concerns as much as possible. Although we are confident that the abutter's concerns can be resolved, it is unlikely that this will occur prior to the 16th.
