Daley was approached by a local Industrial Property Manager, requesting the Town to provide relief to Industrial Zones for the Open Space requirements identified in the town ordinance. L. Daley presented various zoning categories. After having T. Dolan research surrounding community zoning categories, it was found that Milford is in line with most others. It was noted that Hendrix Wire & Cable is now known as Marmon Utilities. Projects proposing less than 30% open space currently requires a variance from the ZBA. The
