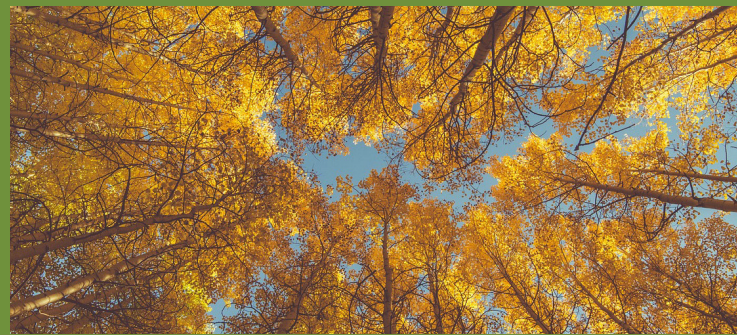


What Conservation Commissions Can Do TO PROTECT NATURAL RESOURCES IN A CHANGING CLIMATE
