2. Amendments to the Milford Development Regulations, Section 6.08 Landscaping Standards.

Chairman C. Beer called the meeting to order at 6:34PM.

## Amendments to the Milford Development Regulations, Section 6.08 Landscaping Standards.

Lincoln Daley began by summarizing the changes and amendments to the Development Regulations Section, 6.08 Landscaping Standards based the input/comments from the Planning Boards received at the July 25, 2017 meeting. The substantive amendments/changes included the following:

- 1) Amend Section 6.08.1 by inserting by references to the national planting materials standards established by the American Nursery and Landscape Association and management/maintenance standards set forth by the American National Standards Institute and the prohibited or restrictive invasive species list maintained by the NH Department of Agriculture.
- 2) Amend Section 6.08.2 to further clarify vegetation management near stonewalls in order to maintain/preserve the aesthetic and historic qualities of stonewalls.
- 3) Amend Section 6.08.2 to further clarify and discourage the usage of spray heads for irrigation and inserting the requirement that head shall be a hybrid of sprays and rotors.
- 4) Amend Section 6.08.4 Mulching to list round stone as an alternative accent material and provided a range of allowable size from 1" to 6".
- 5) Amend Subsection 6.08.7.B to further clarify the type of permitted trees within landscaped or green space areas and minimum branch height when planted.
- 6) Amend Section 6.08.8.A to simplify the minimum planting specifications for deciduous trees, coniferous trees, and shrubberies involving height and size requirements.
- 7) Amend 6.08.8.B to include ornamental round as an alternative to mulch around plantings.
- 8) Amend 6.08.8.C by inserting new subsections 2. and 3 involving the ability to utilize existing non-invasive species and mature vegetation as part of the landscape design and the requirement to manage invasive species and/or toxic plants using accepted horticultural techniques and provisions created by the State of NH and the standards of ANSI A300.7.

9) Amend Subsection 6.08.8.D Alternative Compliance by inserting language providing the opportunity for creative and sustainable designs, materials, techniques, concepts, and technologies, for both standard compliance measures and as part of alternative compliance proposals. The language further provides a process for allowing alternative landscape design onsite and an alternate site.

General discussions by members and staff included encouraging applicants to submit plans that are of higher quality and include a better overall design that goes beyond just meeting the minimum development requirements. In addition, members discussed discouraging the use/inclusion of "or equal to" as it pertains to comparable plant and trees species shown as part of the submitted/approved landscape design

J. Langdell made a motion to move the proposed amendments to Milford Development Regulations, Section 6.08 Landscaping Standards as presented and amended to a scheduled public hearing. D. Knott seconded the motion and Board voted unanimously in favor.
