Chipper Brown requested a fee waiver for the use of Emerson Park for Church services from 6/19
to 9/4/16. (12 Sundays $-9-10 A M=12$ hours : \$240 OR 9-11AM = 24 hours : \$480.)
With reduced fee it would be $\$ 48.00$ or $\$ 96.00$, which represents an $80 \%$ reduction in fees.
Cheri Federico moved and Melissa Sherman seconded that the fees be reduced. All were in favor..

Troy Swanick described the work done at the various parks.
Kaley: removed brush and trees at entrance, aerated field, replaced an irrigation controller.
Adams Field: cleared 20-30 feet on the right side, wood chips placed near Osgood Pond.
Keyes: replaced wooden benches with new ones.
127 Elm: much time was spent removing trees.
Pool: Patching will be done and filter will be replaced. Also it will be pressure washed.
Shepherd: routine maintenance. Carson field will be worked on to be used for a limited number of games.

Kirsten Henderson and Zachary Williamson proposed the construction of a dog park at 127 Elm Street, as the closest dog parks are in Hooksett and Hudson. It was suggested that 1500-2000
sq. ft. would be required, fenced in, as well as a source of running water, a small shelter, bulletin board and trash can. Kirsten and Zachary were encouraged to attend a Keyes Park Expansion Committee meeting and also to obtain as much support from the community as they could.

## Director's Report

Arene introduced John Kohlmorgen as the new Milford Recreation Commission Program Coordinator. John began his new position on 4/25/16. We congratulated John and welcomed him.
Stephanie's last day in the office is $5 / 5$. She will help on an "as needed" basis with programs.

The revolving fund balance is $\$ 27,117.34$.

An April vacation program spreadsheet was presented.
Shows were most popular, so next year it was suggested that 2 or 3 shows were offered and that these would be coordinated with the library's vacation activity schedule.

The suggestion was to put the activities into categories.
Cheri Federico moved to combine lacrosse, basketball and soccer into "Youth Sports."
Scott Hembrow seconded. All were in favor.
John expressed the desire to run a basketball instructional camp. $\$ 40.00$ was requested for the camp. Melissa Sherman moved that the request be granted and Claudia Lemaire seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Keyes Park Expansion Committee has had 2 meetings. Short term and long term needs were identified at the second meeting. The committee meets the first and third Thursday each month.

The Summer Recreation guides are out.
Fall Recreation guides go to print at the beginning of August, therefore ideas are needed soon.

There is one full time Parks and Recreation Commission position and one Alternate position open.
