



## **TOWN OF MILFORD DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IMMEDIATE OPENING FOR Seasonal Laborers and Seasonal Truck Drivers (CDL)**

The Milford Department of Public Works is seeking energetic, dependable and conscientious individual(s) to fill the position(s) of Seasonal Laborers and/or Seasonal Truck Drivers within our Public Works Department.

Duties will include landscaping, grounds & building maintenance, construction activities and other tasks as assigned throughout our Parks, Cemeteries and Highway Departments. Hours generally will be 6:30/7:00 a.m. to 3:00/3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, May to October. Work is performed inside and out of doors in an environment which includes exposure to physical elements and/or to a number of disagreeable working conditions.

**Laborer Experience** - Prefer minimum of 6 (six) months experience performing laboring, grounds keeping or building maintenance work; OR any combination of education and experience which demonstrates possession of the required knowledge, skill and abilities. Starting pay will be commensurate with position/experience - \$18.00/hr DOE up to 29 hrs/week

**CDL Experience** - Applicants holding a CDL encouraged to apply. NH CLASS B CDL required for some functions, CLASS A CDL preferred. Starting pay will be commensurate with position/experience - \$23.00/hr DOE – up to 29 hrs/week

**Requirements** – High School diploma or equivalent, must be at least 18 years of age, possess a valid NH Driver's License, have a steady/dependable work history and be safety conscious.
