Stakeholder Survey Information & Comments Summary

The survey saw 16 individuals representing organizations respond. The team felt it was beneficial to include all comments both positive and negative in the interest of full transparency for the report..

The following paragraphs summarize the comments received:

Question #1: Do you and your organization believe that there is a need for a new public community center in Milford? If yes, what elements should it contain to meet community needs?

Answer Rate – 69% responded to the question

- Gym space for athletes, field space for athletes + activities held by town;
- senior center. Teen age center;
- Senior Center, Meeting Space,;
- Meeting space to host large meetings and events.; The community center should have a dedicated senior center, a teen program, and could collaborate with the Milford School District ATC to offer an early childhood program both for families and to offer to high school students an associate's degree program in ECE. There should also be community health programs, such as healthy cooking classes and exercise programs for people of all ages. And, there could be a Maker's Space and art programs.; Regional focus. Intergenerational Programming opportunities that Seniors and Disabled residents could participate in.;
- Place for youth;
- The community has a need for a place for seniors to go. Host community events and community dinners, rent the community center for parties;
- Space for kids and families as well as a space for local community support services to operate.
- This question is incredibly confusing. The two options leave quite a bit out. The library, the town hall auditorium, the police and ambulance center currently have the only spaces available for the community to meet. They are all very limited small spaces except the town hall auditorium. Except the auditorium is expensive to rent. The Library has been asking for an addition for much needed additional community space for years, but the price tag is always voted down. So they continue to do the best they can to meet community's needs and requests in an old dilapidated building that is incredibly more expensive to maintain as is, than if the myriad problems were at least fixed...;
- There is already a community center. The space is not large;

Answer rate – 100% responded to the question

- Specifically in Sports Volleyball is our focus, however we have experience across multiple sports.; senior center;
- Possibly, the Milford Rotary Club generally does not provide funding for operating budget type expenses, but once up and running, we might be interested in helping support certain specific pilot programs, etc.;
- Events at the library for those who are within walking distance.; Perhaps in helping organize/plan.;
- Yes, but it depends. Not sure I fully understand why the town would work to raise the necessary funds to develop this old property now without first doing everything in their power to assist the library in securing the funds necessary to replace their failed HVAC system, plumbing issues and electrical problems so the library can at least remain open. And potentially putting this option before town voters at the same time the library is desperately requesting funds needed to repair basic infrastructure could mean an either/or decision or worst both could be voted down. I would greatly be in support of a community center AND expanding our town library but I do have some serious concerns. Considering that during the most recent election one party secured control of the state (Governorship, Executive Council, and the State House) the Governor has already announced he intends to make further business tax cuts and other cost reductions in services they offer which means this will most likely result in a property tax increase in most towns in NH. Considering that and the financially devastating period of pandemic that we are currently in, I think it would be best to wait on moving forward with something new and make sure that the town can cover the basic repairs that are most necessary to continuing services...;
- This would be a great opportunity to partner with the Milford School District. If it requires
 a change in state laws for public finance to allow collaboration of services and facilities,
 then our newly elected State Reps should get to work.;
- The Souhegan Valley Transportation Collaborative (SVTC) aka "Blue Bus" primarily serves Seniors and residents living with disabilities in 6 Souhegan Valley towns (Milford, Amherst, Wilton, Brookline, Hollis and Mont Vernon). Our focus is on providing rides to non-emergency health care appointments, social service appointments, senior centers, library visits, grocery shopping, town halls and other destinations within the 6 towns and Nashua. We currently offer/provide rides to Milford Town Hall and, during the summer, to Keyes Memorial Park.;



Not to mention only a handful of ppl would even use such a facility. Those that come up with these ideas must consider self funding and not break the backs of taxpayers. Worry about your fellow man closer to home first please.
- What we really need is a senior center we have nothing like that in our town
- I love this town, but I think this year everyone would agree, lower our taxes and put a



hold on spending some money. That would help everyone no matter the situation currently.





Q3 How far would you and/or your family be willing to travel in order to participate in events at a regional community center?




