In light of concerns about the emerging health crisis associated with the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak as well as the ongoing INFLUENZA season, we are implementing the following to mitigate concerns, protect our employees, and prevent contagion.

As of this date, it is important to recognize that Milford is <u>NOT</u> in a high-risk area. The Town administration continues to monitor the situation on a daily basis and is committed to modifications if and when they become necessary.

The Milford Recreation Department will evaluate upcoming trips, events and programs on a case by case basis. A decision will be made to proceed (with or without modifications), postpone or cancel. An attempt will be made to notify all participants of any changes by email and then by phone call. Please make every attempt to respond to the emails as it is expected for staff to be extra busy with these changes.

For programs, trips and events that are being held as planned we have stepped up our efforts for cleaning and disinfecting areas following the recommendations of the CDC. We also encourage you to follow the recommendations of the CDC which include proper and frequent handwashing and staying home if sick.

If you are not feeling well or are uncomfortable attending our trip, program or event and it's past our typical cancellation period, please stay home. We will offer a more liberal cancellation policy to the community if needed.
