



## Town of Milford Heritage Commission Preserving Important Structures

*Bandstand Designated on Statewide Endangered Properties List  
Restoration Begins on Historic Schoolhouse/Scout House*

August 2022: In 2021, [Milford's Heritage Commission](#) began two significant projects to protect and preserve two major landmarks – the iconic Pillsbury Bandstand situated on the Oval and the Laurel Schoolhouse (also known as the Scout House) at Shepard Park. The Bandstand is now on the NH Preservation Alliance's 2021 ["Seven to Save"](#) list of properties. The Laurel Schoolhouse windows have been made operational and new [granite steps](#) were installed in April 2022.
